Can I be assisted at the polling station to vote?

According to the law, voting is a secret.

If you have physical disabilities

you may ask for assistance.

If you can't read Arabic

Lists colour coding and pictures of the candidates makes it easier to identify.

Can I ask to change the voting poll station allocated to me or have a proxy vote?

No

Who will be allowed in the voting poll stations outside Lebanon?

- 1. The voter
- 2. The head of the polling station
- 3. A staff member of the embassy/consulate
- 4. Representatives of the candidates/lists/parties
- 5. The Lebanese Association for Democratic Elections (LADE)
- 6. Representatives of the EU

It is important to note that if you are registered to vote abroad, you will not be able to vote in Lebanon. You have to vote in the country where you registered.

Do not abstain. Do not vote blank. Vote for change.

WHAT TO DO ON VOTING DAY



SIMPLE STEPS TOWARDS CHANGE.

1 Have the correct documents:

Your Lebanese ID card (plastic) **OR** your valid Lebanese passport

If you only hold an expired blue passport (2003+), you can validate it for election purposes at your local consulate or at the polling station.

- Once you reach your assigned polling station, the head of the voting poll verifies your identity/passport and checks if your name is on the list of eligible voters.
- You are handed the official ballot relevant to your district and constituency + envelope

Make the correct choice:

Enter the isolation unit alone. In the appropriate square, mark an \mathbf{X} or \checkmark to cast your vote for your list of choice and if you wish, cast your preferential vote for one of the candidates within that same list.

Note that it is only possible to vote for the candidates from your own constituency, the black slots are for candidates from other constituencies. Any marks other than an X or $\sqrt{}$ will cancel your ballot.

- Fold and place the paper in the envelope.
- Exit the isolation unit and personally insert the envelope into the box.
- Sign or stamp next to your name on the cross-off list.
- OB Dip your finger in the blue ink.

O1 Why should I vote on election day?

Voting is a civic duty.

You are not doing a favour for the candidate but for the country.

Vote vs Complain

If you don't vote, you cannot complain about the state of the country. Boycotting means sacrificing your right to vote as a citizen and could prolong the crisis.

For accountability

Being elected is not the end goal. We are voting to elect members of parliament who we will hold accountable if they don't deliver on promises.

For the future

The crisis is not going to end overnight; it is a long process requiring Lebanese efforts; the international community has far bigger fish to fry.

O2 If I decide to vote, how should I cast my ballot?

New and independent

No list is perfect. However, there are many candidates with integrity and are truly seeking to reform the country. At the very least, voting for change undermines the ruling mafia.

Assess and decide

In most districts there are candidates who have a high chance of exceeding the threshold in that district. Decide based on rationale and statistics, if they exist.

What if I don't believe in any of the candidates and/or lists?

Protest vote

You can cast a "spoiled ballot". A spoiled ballot unlike a "white ballot" will not support status quo candidates. For instance you can write a slogan on the ballot such as "see you in 2026".

DO NOT ABSTAIN. DO NOT VOTE BLANK. VOTE FOR CHANGE.
